DOJ Recommendation #: 8.2

Supervisors should be held accountable for ensuring accurate and complete entry for all use of force data reporting.

Purpose:

A Department Bulletin was written as a revision to DB 15-237 which outlines use of force procedures and a step by step guide on how to accurately complete the new Supervisory Use of Force Evaluation Form.

A Use of Force Audit Form was created by RMO to random audit 10 use of force evaluations on a monthly basis.

Policy:

This department bulletin mandates that supervisor must complete a Supervisory Use of Force Evaluation Form for each reportable use of force and submit through the chain of command before the end of their watch.
