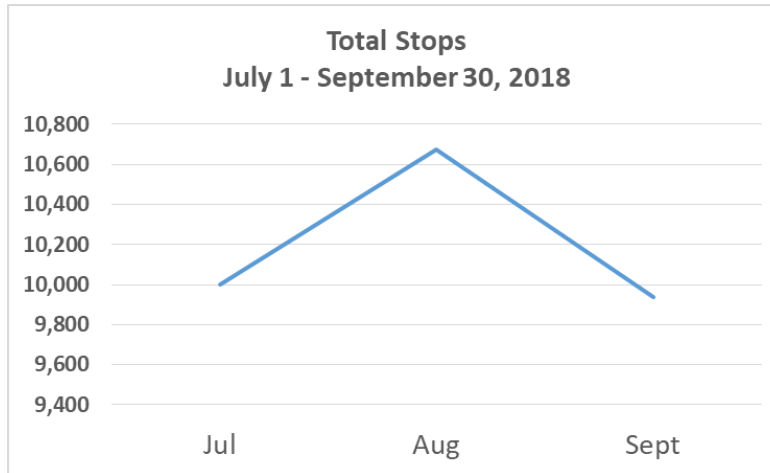

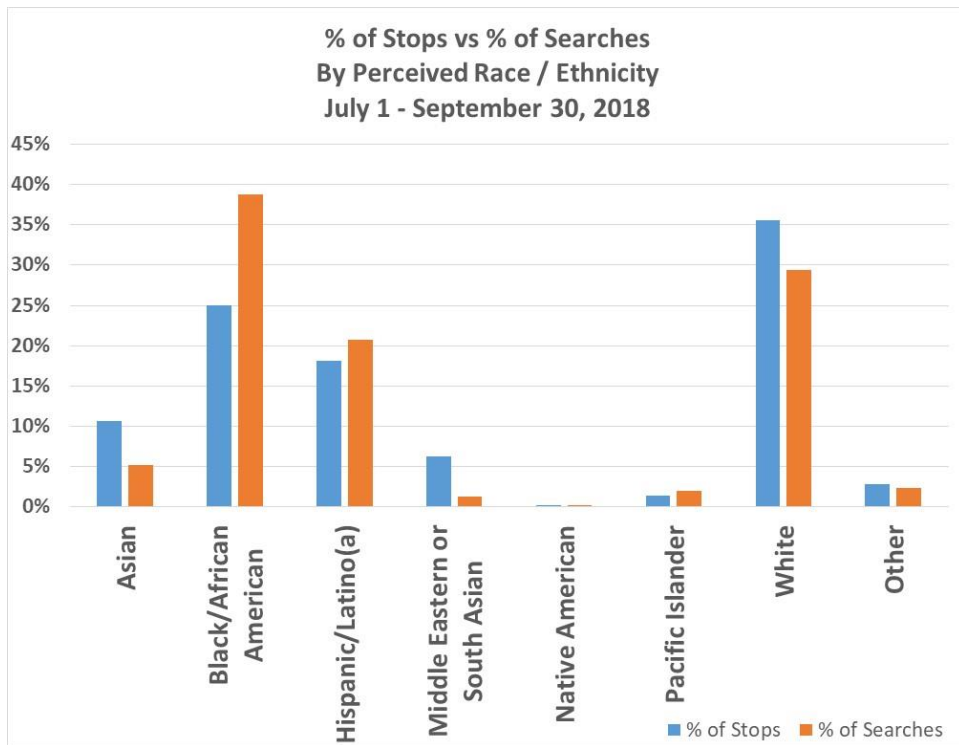

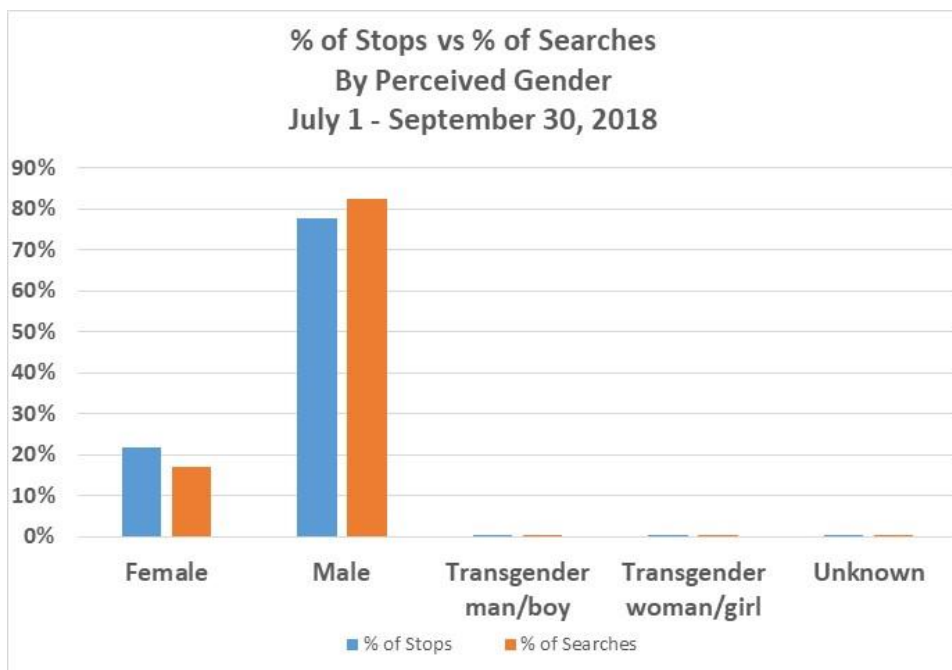

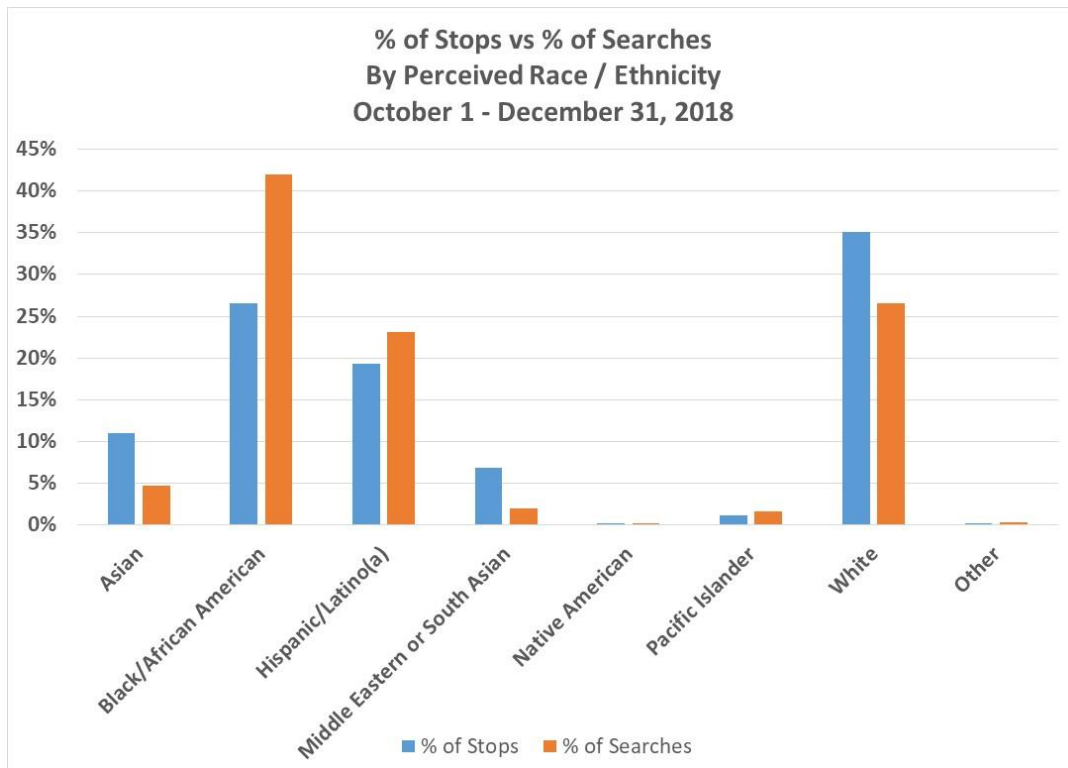

## 2019 Quarter 1 Summary Statistics by District



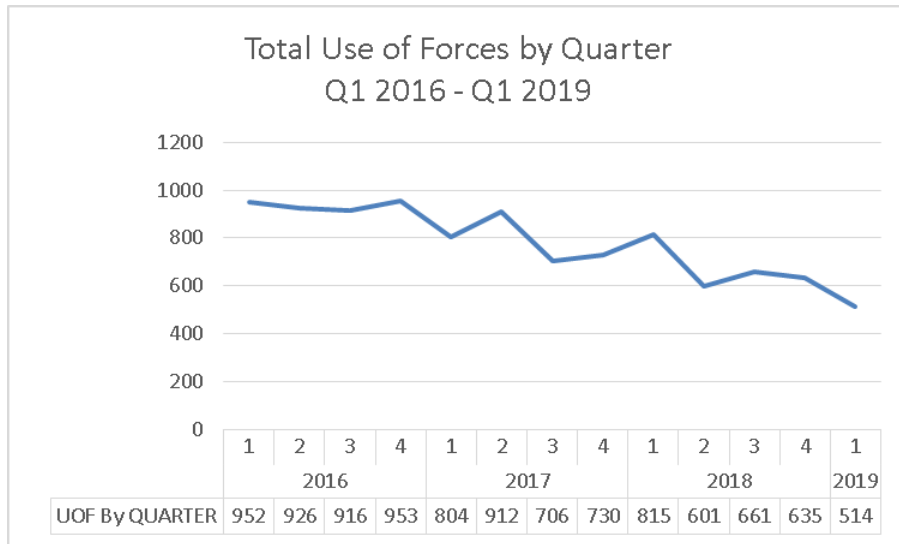

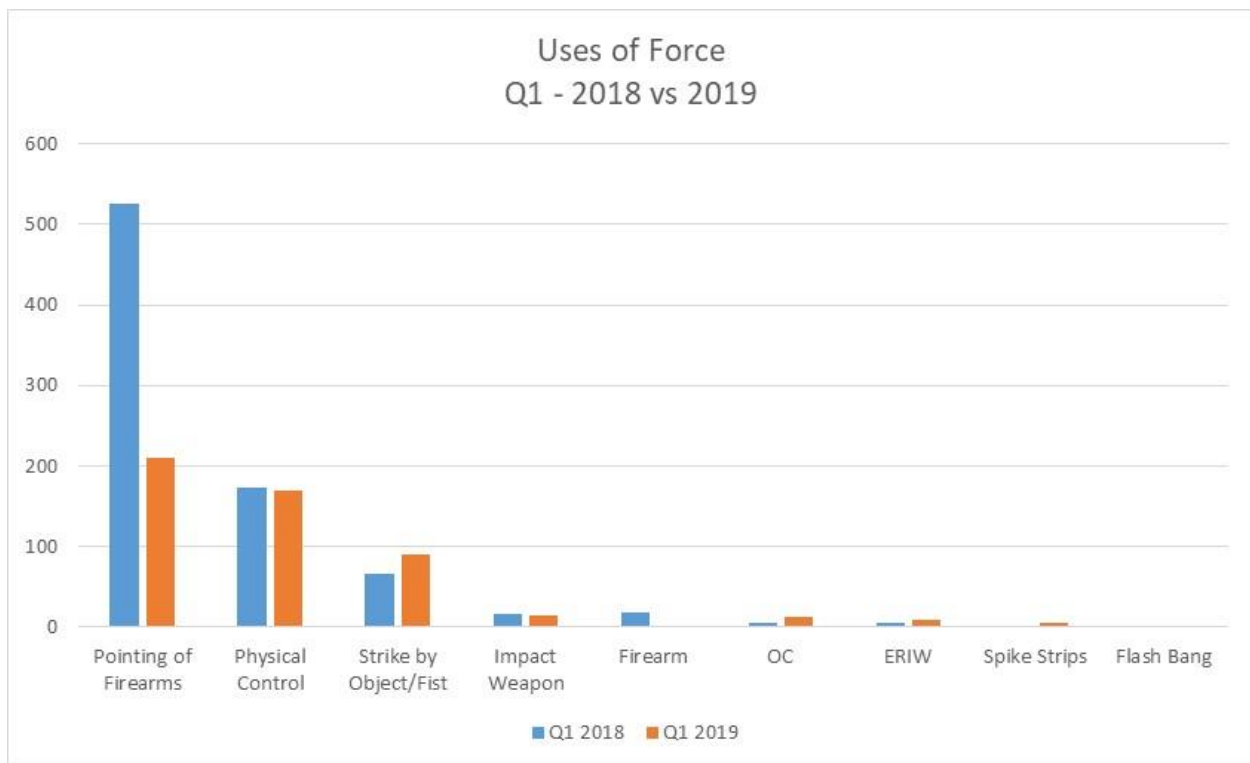

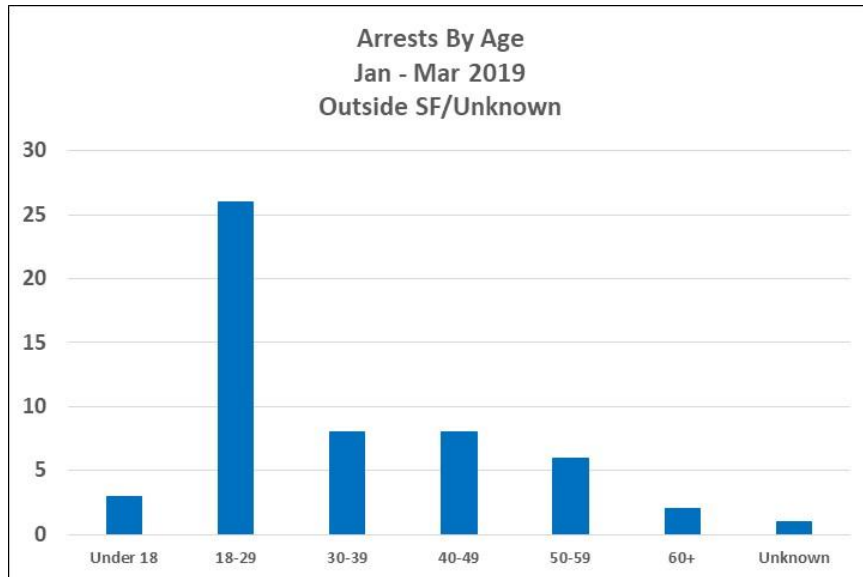

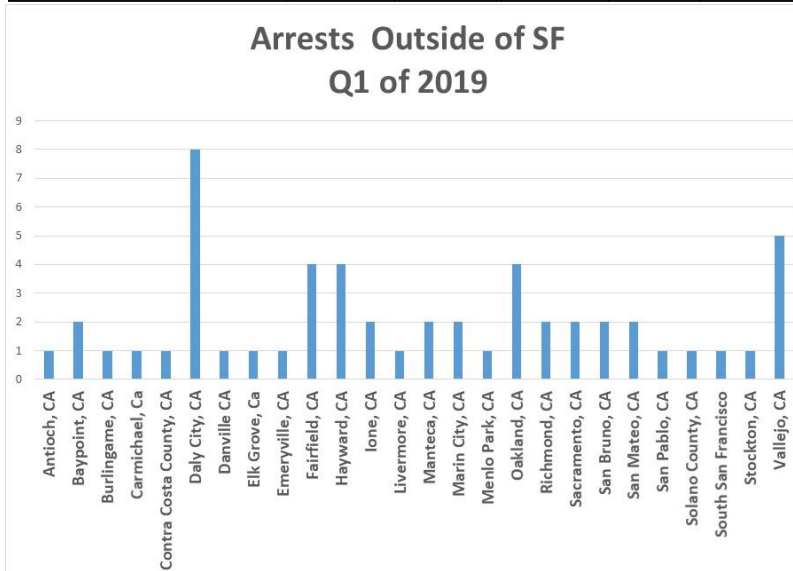
