National Association of Women Law Enforcement Executives 27th Annual Conference

One of the 30x30's founding partners will host the 27th Annual National Association of Women Law Enforcement Executives (NAWLEE) Conference in Houston, TX, on April 11-14, 2023. This year's theme is "Empowered to be the Difference."

The purpose of this conference is to provide continual support for women in law enforcement, which will include general sessions on promising practices, breakouts, vendors, and networking opportunities for women in law enforcement. The conference will also include tracks to help women officers connect by rank-seeking advancement in their law enforcement careers.

The National Association of Women Law Enforcement Executives was created to promote women in law enforcement, and membership is open to women and men, both sworn and professional staff, that support the advancement of women in all ranks and roles in the law enforcement profession. The NAWLEE provides training, mentoring, programs, and resources to help women and their agencies pursue and provide opportunities for women to advance.

NAWLEE seeks to inspire women to enter the field of law enforcement, empower them to recognize and develop their leadership potential and achieve their own career goals. At the same time, NAWLEE can assist departments in recruiting and training efforts to provide an inclusive environment for women in law enforcement.
