Pursuit Driving Policy Training; Vehicle Code Section 17004.7(b)(1)



California Vehicle Code §17004.7(b)(1) mandates that peace officers receive annual training on pursuit driving and pursuit policy.

Training Coordinators will be provided roll-call training packets with the necessary training materials and forms to properly present this regular and periodic training, as well as the attestation form to document that members have received, read, and understood the policy. This training shall be completed by November 4, 2016.

Effective 0001 hours on November 5, 2016, no sworn members shall operate a Department vehicle unless they have first completed §17004.7 training and have signed the “Pursuit Policy Training Attestation Form” and the “Roll Call Training Acknowledgement Form,” attesting that they have completed the training. Signed Attestation and Acknowledgement Forms shall be scanned and emailed to SFPD.Training@sfgov.org. Original forms must be maintained at the unit. Training Coordinators must enter all members into HRMS to document the training received (under Course Code: RC2016 / Course Session: 0002 / Course Description: Roll Call Training 2016 / Pursuit Policy Training).

Each Commanding Officer and Officer in Charge shall take all steps necessary to ensure that mandated training is presented to and completed by all sworn members in their respective commands prior to November 5, 2016. Members returning from approved leaves after November 5th, must be given training immediately upon their return (so that they may drive a Department vehicle). Training coordinators must submit a non-compliance list to the Academy’s Professional Development Unit through their commanding officers. Additionally, Commanding Officers and Officers in Charge shall ensure that no sworn member operates a department vehicle after November 4, 2016, unless properly trained.
