Off-Duty Concealed Carry PROHIBITED at AT&T Park

Effective 03/30/2017, off-duty law enforcement officers who do not have an authorized, working, event-day function, will be banned from bringing weapons into AT&T Park. No firearms will be allowed into AT&T Park except for those carried by law enforcement officers working in a pre-approved event-day capacity and assigned to the event. This ban will also apply to licensed CCW patrons.

This policy was enacted on June 1, 2014 for a number of reasons, including the fact that AT&T Park is secured through a number of measures including, but not limited to magnetometers, metal detecting wands, pat-downs and explosive detection canines.

In the past, SFPD allowed verified law-enforcement personnel to carry weapons into AT&T Park if such personnel identified themselves to ballpark security and registered their seating location with SFPD. This practice is no longer applicable. As such, you will be denied access to enter the ballpark if you are off-duty and carrying a firearm. There will be NO weapons storage on the property. Members are required to adhere to Department Bulletin 15-210, Firearm Security in Vehicles, and should familiarize themselves with San Francisco Police Code 3602B as it relates to the storage of firearms.
