Training Video regarding Cross Reports between the San Francisco Police Department and Family and Children Services

The San Francisco Police Department and Family and Children Services (CPS) have collaborated to create the San Francisco Law Enforcement Protocol for Child Abuse Investigation.

The goal of the video is to educate officers in how to conduct a proper child abuse investigation that will reduce and limit the stress to the children involved, while still satisfying their legal requirements as members of law enforcement.
