Reports regarding Vicious and Dangerous Dogs

(Supersedes DB 17-008)

All reports regarding vicious and dangerous dogs including all dog bite and attack reports should be assigned and emailed to the Vicious and Dangerous Dog Unit (VDDU).

Members can email the report or case # to SFPDdangerousDogs@sfgov.org and document the emailing in the report narrative.

All other dog related reports including reports documenting stray dogs, dog fighting, dog abandonment, dog barking, animal cruelty, animal fighting, animal poisoning and animal without proper care or attention should be emailed, but not assigned, to the Vicious and Dangerous Dog Unit.

In all cases of dog bites, members should complete the Animal Bite Report SFPD Form 573 revised 11/16 (located in SFPD Forms folder) and attach the form to the incident report.

Members shall NOT fax a copy of the police report to SF Animal Care and Control.
