Executive Summary:

DOJ Objective: Recruitment, Hiring Personnel Practices

DOJ Recommendation #: 66.3

The SFPD should provide twice-yearly reports to the Police Commission regarding actions resulting from the Sparks Report, including whether the OCC recommendation is supported and the timeline for implementation or correction to existing practice and policy.

*It should be noted that the Office of Citizen Complaints (OCC) is now known as the Department of Police Accountability (DPA).

Purpose:

Chief Scott issued a written directive on 02/22/17 that commits to meeting with the DPA regarding the Sparks Report and additional relevant business matters including the twice yearly reporting requirements.

To comply with the Chiefs order and to directly address DOJ Recommendation 66.3, a PSPPB unit order 17-001 was issued by Deputy Chief Connolly requiring the Professional Standards and Principled Policing Bureau (PSPPB) to develop the twice yearly report as required by this DOJ task.

This policy mandates the Department will provide a twice yearly report regarding the Sparks Report to the Police Commission.
