## Officer-Involved Discharge 001-14

Incident Date: January 25, 2014

Location: 1700 Block of Connecticut Street

Finding: In Policy

At approximately 10:26 AM, Bayview Housing officers were following up on a trespassing investigation. The subject of their investigation became angry and released his pit bull, named Psycho. Psycho charged one of the officers, who retreated toward a retaining wall. The officer stumbled as he climbed the wall to escape the charging dog. He fell to the ground as the snarling dog closed in. Scared that the attacking dog was about to maul him, the officer fired one time from his Department-issued handgun, fatally striking the dangerous animal and stopping its attack.



## Officer-Involved Discharge 002-14

Incident Date: January 28, 2014

Location: Golden Gate Park (25<sup>th</sup> Avenue meadow, between Lincoln & MLK)

Finding: In Policy

At approximately 10:45 PM, officers from three districts, responding to 25<sup>th</sup> and Lincoln, locating two pit bull dogs circling three people, one of whom was unconscious on the ground with significant bite injuries. Officers rescued the civilians and attempted to contain the dangerous animals. An ACC officer arrived, but his attempts to capture the dogs failed. The ACC officer reported that the dogs were dangerous and a threat to the public. After one of the dogs managed to escape into the park, the remaining dog was shot by a lieutenant using a patrol rifle, because of the danger presented by the animal. The lieutenant fired a second time, using his Department-issued handgun, to end further suffering by the mortally wounded dog.

## Status of Open Officer-Involved Shooting Investigations



### Open OIS Cases Summary

There are currently **twenty (20) open OIS cases**. The previous OIS Quarterly Report was presented to the Police Commission on February 5, 2014. Since the last report:

- Three (3) cases were completed, with all findings presented and documentation completed: OIS 11-003, 11-005, and 11-006.
- Three (3) new cases were opened: OIS 14-002 (2/4/14), 14-003 (3/8/14), and OIS 14-004 (3/21/14).
- Five (5) cases have open and active criminal investigations.
- One (1) charging decision letter was received from the Office of the District Attorney; the final report was completed by the Homicide Detail and forwarded to the Internal Affairs Division.
- **Eleven (11) cases** are in review by the Office of the District Attorney. Either final DA reports (DA's internal documentation) or the consequent charging decision letters are being prepared for these cases.
