Healthy Streets Operation Center (HSOC) Homelessness, Substance Abuse and Other Services

The Healthy Streets Operations Center (HSOC) is open from 0700 to 2300 hours, 7 days a week and is a collaboration between the Department (SFPD), Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH), Homeless Outreach Team (HOT), Department of Public Health (DPH), Department of Public Works (DPW), Department of Emergency Management (DEM), the City's Controller's Office, and 311.

Members encountering homeless individuals in need of shelter, substance abuse or mental health treatment should phone the **Healthy Streets Operations Center at** during the hours of operation.

A Department member at HSOC will work to secure shelter or available services on the member's behalf, including confirming which services are available and where the person may be taken or directed. Members may also contact HSOC directly when requesting, Department of Public Works (DPW) (for homeless related issues) or the Homeless Outreach Team (HOT).
