Three of the stops noted above indicated as resulting in contact with Department of Homeland Security (DHS) occurred at the San Francisco International Airport when individuals were released to the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), a subordinate agency of DHS, after contraband was found at a security checkpoint. One stop was related to a subject entering a restricted location of San Francisco International Airport, while TSA was also on scene - subject was cited and released. One incident occurred, also at San Francisco International Airport, in which a missing person was contacted by Customs and Border Patrol – SFPD responded and incident was referred to San Mateo Police Department.

Total Use of Force Overview January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019












