Leadership San Francisco 2021

Leadership San Francisco (LSF) is an organization dedicated to educating and developing community trustees who will make a significant contribution to strengthen and transform our community. Their signature program develops future community leaders who are both knowledgeable about the City and concerned with its well-being. Each year, approximately 50 future community leaders are selected to attend LSF's 10-month program.

Participants are given a unique opportunity to explore the social and economic challenges facing San Francisco's leaders and learn how they, as individuals, may respond to community concerns.

Member(s) will be selected to attend LSF 2021. Any commissioned officer who meets the program's participation requirements should submit a memorandum with resume, through their chain of command, to the Captain of the Training Division. The memorandum should detail the applicant's work experience, future goals, and the benefits the applicant believes this course will provide. Final selection will be made by Chief Scott. Members shall not contact Leadership San Francisco directly to enroll. The deadline to submit requests will be 14 days after the posting of this notice.

Leadership San Francisco 2021 Course Schedule:

Attending a two-day overnight retreat Friday, September 11 and Saturday, September 12, 2020.

Ten full-day sessions, one per month from September through June.

Serving on a planning committee for at least one session.
