Resumption of Store Hours for Essential Businesses that Sell Alcohol

Effective June 19th, 2020, the provision within Mayor Breed's Emergency Proclamation that requires essential businesses which sell alcohol to close between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. each day is rescinded. Establishments that fall within this category may resume previous store hours in accordance with established regulations of the California Department of Alcohol and Beverage Control in conjunction with the City & County of San Francisco.

TERMINATION OF ORDER ISSUED UNDER PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, On February 25, 2020, I declared a Local State of Emergency to exist within the City and County of San Francisco in connection with the imminent spread within the City of a novel (new) coronavirus ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, On March 27, 2020, I issued the Sixth Supplement to the Emergency Proclamation containing an Order in Section 4 that requires certain essential businesses that sell alcohol to close between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. each day; and

WHEREAS, The circumstances no longer require the continuation of this Order to respond to the local emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE

I, London N. Breed, Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco terminate the Order contained in Section 4 of the Sixth Supplement to the Emergency Proclamation, effective at 6:00 a.m. on June 19, 2020.
