Daylight Saving Time Starts – Spring 2021

Pacific Daylight Saving Time will begin Sunday, March 14, 2021, at 0200 hours. With the exception of the Hall of Justice clocks, which are self-regulating and should not be readjusted manually, all clocks shall be set ahead sixty minutes at that hour.

ENFORCEMENT OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL ACT, SECTION 25631 B&P

Retail hours of sale

Any on or off-sale license, or agent or employee of such license, who sells, gives or delivers to any person any alcoholic beverage or knowingly purchases any alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2 A.M. and 6 A.M. of the same day is guilty of a misdemeanor.

For the purpose of this section, on the day that the change occurs from Pacific Standard Time to Pacific Daylight Time, "2 A.M." means two hours after midnight of the day preceding the day the change occurs.
