"Purpose" Codes for the III Mask in CLETS

The reason for this Notice is to advise CLETS users of the requirement to select the proper "Purpose" code when using the Interstate Identification Index ("III" Mask) referred to as "Triple I." During a recent audit it was discovered that some users were not using the proper codes.

The audit revealed the following common mistakes:

- Purpose code "D" improperly used when conducting a check for domestic violence or drug possession cases,
- Purpose code "F" improperly used for disorderly conduct arrest cases, and
- Purpose code "J" improperly used for narcotics, weapons and resisting arrest cases.

Per the FBI, all of the above inquiries should use Purpose code "C." In fact <u>Purpose</u> code "C" should be used for the <u>majority of III Mask checks.</u>

Additional wording has been added to Purpose code "C" to remind users conducting III Mask checks to use this code for the majority of investigations:
