

BAYVIEW COMMUNITY UPDATE November 30, 2004

Sex Offender Information

A Bayview resident inquired last week about sex offender information and how it is accessed. The procedures for accessing this information are constantly changing, and are about to change again due to a recent Assembly bill. Currently, all High Risk sex offender information is available through a link on the department's website. However, addresses for these individuals are not provided, only general residential areas, such as zip codes. If you wish information on both High Risk and Serious offenders, you may access it through a server located in our Sexual Offender Unit which utilizes an intranet connection. If you wish to access the information in this way, please phone Inspectors Zerga or Serna in our Sexual Offender Unit at 553-9203 to make an appointment. Beginning July 1, 2005 (at the latest), all 100,000 registered sex offenders in the state of California will be entered into a database which will be accessible on the internet. Some of these offenders will have their home address listed (such as child molesters), while others will list only a general area, such as a zip code.

Crime and Enforcement Update

On November 29, at 8:51 a.m., the property manager at 90 Kiska Road reported to Bayview officers that someone had shot through her window. An expended round was located inside the office and booked as evidence (041 356 848).

On November 29, at 9:17 a.m., Bayview officers were on patrol at Phelps and Kirkwood when they saw a woman, known to them as a local 'working girl,' pacing back and forth on the sidewalk and waving at cars as they passed. The officers watched the woman for several minutes and saw that she continued walking the same stretch of sidewalk and motioning to cars as they passed by her. The officers eventually booked the woman for loitering for purposes of prostitution activity (041 357 131).

On November 29, at 9:33 a.m., Bayview officers responded to the 2700 block of San Bruno Avenue on a threats report. The female caller told officers that her ex-boyfriend had phoned her numerous times and threatened to kill her. The victim's sister then took the victim's child to school and saw the ex-boyfriend at the school, apparently waiting for the victim to arrive. Later in the day, the victim phoned police to say that her ex-boyfriend was now at her place of work. Bayview officers responded and arrested the ex-boyfriend, charging him with making terrorist threats (041 357 153).

On November 29, at 12:19 p.m., Bayview officers were dealing with a homeless encampment at 24th and Minnesota when they came across a woman who was wanted for an outstanding arrest warrant. The woman was arrested and an arrest search revealed a quantity of ecstasy tablets. The woman was charged with the drug charges and the warrants (041 358 775).

On November 29, at 1:08 p.m., Bayview officers were on patrol on the 100 block of Westpoint when they saw a man they knew to be wanted for an

outstanding arrest warrant. The man, living in Union City, was booked for the warrant (041 358 399).

On November 29, at 1:34 p.m., Bayview officers were on patrol at Phelps and Innes when they stopped a woman for walking into traffic. The officers determined that the woman had an outstanding arrest warrant charging her with burglary. The woman, living on Nichols Way, was booked for the warrant (010 582 816).

On November 29, at 3:00 p.m., Bayview officers were on patrol at Newcomb and Toland when they were flagged down by a woman living in a vehicle. The woman told officers that she had been involved in a fight with a person living in an RV down the street. The victim signed a private person arrest against the suspect, who was arrested and charged with battery. The suspect was also charged with an outstanding arrest warrant charging him with stolen auto, possession of stolen property and possession of burglar tools (041 359 579).

On November 29, at 3:11 p.m., Bayview officers responded to a home on the 900 block of Connecticut on the report of a hot prowl burglary (person home at time of burglary). The caller told officers that she was in her home when she heard the sound of glass breaking coming from one of her bedrooms. The victim ran out of her house, and then saw a suspect jump from a window and run south on Connecticut. The suspect is a black male, 22-25, 5'7", 150 (041 358 963).

On November 29, at 4:04 p.m., Bayview officers were on patrol at Phelps and Innes when they saw a man they had recently arrested for drug charges riding a bicycle down the sidewalk. The officers stopped the man for the sidewalk violation and he began to dig his hand into his jacket pocket. The officers patted the man down and located two chunks of crack cocaine in his pocket. The man, living on the 1600 block of Kirkwood, was booked for possession of cocaine (041 359 165).

On November 29, at 4:49 p.m., Bayview officers responded to 3rd and Shafter on a robbery call. The victim told officers that he was walking on Lane toward Palou when he was approached by two suspects, one of whom placed a hard object against his back and stated, "Give me all of your money." The suspects then fled on foot. Suspect one is a black male, 16-17, 5'7", 150, wearing all black clothing. Suspect two is a black male, 5'8", 180, wearing all black clothing (041 359 331).
