District Night Clubs Out of Control

We had problems (again) at two of our district nightclubs Saturday night, and all of our Bayview officers, as well as officers from adjoining districts, had to be called in to address the riotous conditions at these two "parties." I contacted the City Attorney's office this morning to discuss a plan which will address what has now become a regular occurrence. It appears that some of our nightclub owners are of the opinion that there are no consequences for adversely affecting the quality of life and safety of Bayview residents. They are mistaken.

Crime and Enforcement Update

Burglary Arrest, 301 Rhode Island, July 24, 3:40 a.m.

Bayview Officers Batchelder and Singh responded on a burglary in progress call and spoke with a security guard who had seen a male suspect entering a locked parking area of the building at 301 Rhode Island. The officers searched the parking area and located a man who matched the description provided by the security guard. The man was found to have in his possession articles stolen from a vehicle parked in the lot. The owner of the boosted auto was contacted and identified the property as hers. The security guard identified the suspect as the same person seen breaking into the garage. The suspect, living on the 1200 block of Newhall, was booked for burglary and violation of parole. The suspect is on active parole for a burglary conviction (050 824 236).

Warrant Arrest, 43 Dakota, July 24, 1:33 p.m.

Bayview's plainclothes team responded to a home on Dakota Street to serve a felony warrant on a person who had provided this address. The suspect was located and booked for a warrant charging her with possession of cocaine (050 181 428).

Aggravated Assault, 700 block of Thornton, July 24, 2:15 p.m.

Bayview Officer Ellis took a report from a woman who stated that her ex-boyfriend had just rammed her vehicle with his vehicle as she drove down Thornton Street. The ex-boyfriend then chased the victim and boxed her in when she tried to exit her vehicle at her friend's home. The ex-boyfriend threatened to shoot the victim and eventually fled. The ex-boyfriend, Damont Kimble, is 26 years of age and lives on the 1400 block of LaSalle. He currently has an (unrelated) warrant for his arrest and, according to the victim, is known to carry firearms. The suspect's car was located and towed by Bayview officers. Kimble is wanted for aggravated assault and death threats (050 825 494).

Warrant Arrest, 1465 LaSalle, July 24, 2:58 p.m.

Bayview's plainclothes team was conducting a follow-up investigation for an aggravated assault incident involving a vehicle (above) and came across a woman with an outstanding criminal warrant from San Bruno. The woman, living on Putnam, was booked for the warrant (050 825 494).

Hot Prowl Burglary, 1700 block of Silver, July 24, 4:50 p.m.

Bayview Officer Chu responded on a burglary call and met with the elderly (81) and bedridden woman who reported that, when her caretaker went to buy some groceries, two suspects entered her room. Both suspects wore hoods and one of them was armed with a black gun. The suspects stole the victim's purse and then fled. Suspect one is a black male, 16-18, 5'6", 130, wearing all black clothing, hood over face and gloves, armed with a gun. Suspect two is a black male, 5'10", 170, wearing all black clothing, a black beanie, dark sunglasses and black gloves (050 826 022).

Vandalism, 400 Tocoloma, July 24, 6:53 p.m.

Bayview Officers Rightmire and McCormick responded on a vandalism call and spoke with the male caller who reported that a well known neighborhood nuisance had been seen vandalizing a fence in the children's playground. The suspect is the subject of a City Attorney code abatement action due to numerous violations at his residence on Lathrop (050 826 345).

Aggravated Assault, 1700 block of Oakdale, July 24, 7:10 p.m.

Bayview Officers Cruz and Festa responded to SFGH on the report of a shooting victim who had just walked into the hospital. The officers attempted to interview the victim, who had been shot on Oakdale Avenue, but the victim refused to answer any questions and refused to cooperate with the investigation (050 826 317).

Attempted Murder, 100 block of Harbor Road, July 24, 8:44 p.m.

Bayview Officers McCormick and Rightmire responded on a shooting call and entered the apartment given as the location of the shooting. The officers found a trail, and several pools, of blood and then found two women hiding in a closet. The women reported that they had heard gunshots in front of their unit and had taken refuge in a closet when they heard their front door being kicked in. The women then saw an injured man run into their apartment and exit a window onto the roof. Responding officers cordoned off the area searching for both a victim and any possible suspects, but none were located. Anonymous witnesses provided the street names of two victims they stated had been shot by a suspect described as a black male, 15-16, wearing a black "hoodie" with the letters "LW" in white print on the back, and black pants (050 826 577).

Robbery, 25th and Wisconsin, July 24, 9:20 p.m.

Bayview Officers Singh and Batchelder responded on a robbery call and spoke with the female victim who reported that she was waiting in a bus stop when she was approached by three suspects who robbed her of her personal property. Suspect one is black female, 22-25, 5'4", 120, braided hair, wearing a black leather jacket and black jeans. Suspect two is a black male, 5'11", 195, wearing a black baseball cap, black sweater with white T-shirt underneath, and dark blue jeans. Suspect three is a black male, 6'2", 200, wearing all dark clothing (050826 618).

Stolen Auto Arrest, Silver and Girard, July 25, 4:07 a.m.
Bayview Officers Batchelder and Singh were on patrol when they stopped a vehicle for traffic violations and determined that it was a stolen auto. The driver, living in East Palo Alto, was booked for stolen auto and driving with a suspended license (050 827 105).
