Late Night Bayview All-Stars versus the SFPD

Crime and Enforcement Update

Aggravated Assault, 1499 Thomas, July 11, 9:44 p.m.

Bayview Officers Norris and Whitfield responded on a call of a drunk male and located a man lying on the sidewalk and bleeding from his mouth. The victim couldn't tell the officers what had happened to him, but a witness stated that the victim had been hit over the head with a bottle by a second drunk male, who was part of a group of 4 or 5 males who had been drinking on the corner (050 775 833).

Terrorist Threats, first block of Cashmere, July 12, 12:05 a.m.

Bayview Officers Wise and Borgen responded on a fight in progress call and spoke with the female caller who reported that her 24 year old son was armed with a hammer and had threatened her and "...broke (her) sh\_\_." The woman told officers that her son had asked for a cigarette, and when she told him to go buy his own he became angry and threw an ash tray at a mirror, breaking it. The woman then armed herself with a toy baseball bat and her son armed himself with a hammer. The son then threatened to do bodily harm to the mother, and she phoned the police. The son was arrested and booked for vandalism and threats. The son, when questioned by the officers, stated that he had a right to break the mirror, since he had given it to his mother as a gift! Threats, 1000 block of Ingerson, July 12, 12:30 p.m.

Bayview Officers Doherty and Lamma responded on a threats call and spoke with the female caller who reported that her brother had threatened to kill both her and her parents. The threats took place after the victim had told her brother that the "word on the street" was that "armed crack users" were preparing to rob or kill the brother, because he too is a drug dealer. This angered the brother, and he then threatened (over the phone) to kill his entire family. The victim stated that her brother is "on drugs" and is capable of carrying out the threat. An Emergency Protective Order was

obtained, and the brother, Albert Otis, is wanted for making death threats (050 778 291).

Domestic Violence, first block of Northridge, July 12, 2:33 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Bodisco and Sanders responded on a disturbance call and spoke with the female victim who reported that her boyfriend had just assaulted her and stolen her property, and the boyfriend's new girlfriend had then pepper-sprayed her. The boyfriend was located and arrested and booked for domestic violence, robbery, trespassing, driving with a suspended license, and an outstanding arrest warrant (050 778 564).

Possession Forged Checks, 4850 3rd Street, July 12, 3:55 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Pai and Reyes responded on the report of a check fraud and found the woman described by Dispatch inside the check cashing store. The caller told officers that the woman had attempted to cash a suspicious looking check, and when he called the Bank of America to verify funds, he was told that the account did not exist. The woman, living on the 1400 block of Underwood, was booked for check fraud and burglary (050 778 796).

Assault with a Knife, 1600 block of Palou, July 12, 5:55 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Johnson and Erb responded on a call that a woman had been stabbed in the throat. The woman was being treated by medical personnel and was transported to SFGH, where the officers interviewed her. The victim reported that she had an argument with a female friend, and the friend became angry and threw a bicycle at her. The victim then fled on foot from the suspect, but was chased down and stabbed twice in the neck with a long knife. The suspect is known as "Mimi," and is 17-18 years of age, 5'5", 112, with long braided hair, wearing a white bandanna, white T-shirt, and blue jean pants (050 779 255).

Methamphetamine Arrest, 226 Missouri, July 11, 7:25 p.m.  
Bayview plainclothes officers were conducting an investigation following the arrest of numerous individuals for maintaining a home where narcotics are being sold when a female resident returned home. The woman denied all knowledge of the large quantity of narcotics, the numerous gang members, and the many pitbull dogs found in her home. She was booked for numerous drug offenses and for child endangerment (050 775 548).

Threats, Vandalism, 4622 3rd Street, July 12, 7:30 p.m.  
Bayview Officer Madrid took a report from a woman who stated that she was standing at her mother's business on 3rd Street when a female acquaintance came up to her and stated that she (the acquaintance) was "...the baddest and prettiest bitch on the block." The second woman then threatened to shoot the victim and her mother. The second woman was later seen by the first woman breaking out a window on the victim's mother's car. The suspect, Iesha Burrow, is wanted for threats and vandalism (050 779 910).

Aggravated Assault, 80 Dakota, July 12, 8:35 p.m.  
Bayview Officers Marchand and Olson responded on a stabbing call and spoke with the male victim who reported that a female acquaintance had attempted to stab him, and had then struck him on his head with a metal pipe. The suspect fled the scene and is named Jermain Jones. The suspect drives a white Acura Legend and lives near 25th and Dakota (050 779 807).

Threats, Navy Road, July 12, 10:00 p.m.

Bayview Officer Robinson took a report from a woman who stated that the father of her child had threatened to kill her following an argument over child visitation. The victim believes that the suspect and his family have been stalking her, and the suspect told her "...watch you head," because he had his "bitch" with him also. The suspect is Kelvin Battle, and he is wanted for making death threats (050 780 315).
