Crime and Enforcement Update

On January 9th at 3:15pm officer from the housing unit had knowledge of some outstanding warrants for an individual that lives on the 1900 block of 25th Street. Armed with that knowledge the officers went to the address and arrested the suspect. Incident to the arrest the suspect told the officers that he had heroin under his bed. The evidence was recovered and he was booked for the narcotics offense as well as the warrants. (050031588)

On January 9th at 8pm in the area of 3rd and Newcomb when the officer were forced to slam on their brakes to avoid a collision with a vehicle that cut
