Crime and Enforcement Update

On February 14, at 5:30 a.m., Bayview Officers Cahill, Damonte and Farrell were on patrol at 16th and Illinois when they saw a homeless man they knew to be wanted and arrested him for an outstanding parole warrant (050 174 401).

On February 14, at 7:59 a.m., Bayview Officers Cohen and Hurley responded to Newhall and Newcomb on the report of four men dealing drugs. The four men began walking in different directions as the officers arrived, and the officers stopped them and determined that one of them had an outstanding warrant for his arrest (drug warrant). The officers arrested the man and he stated that he was having problems breathing, so they took him to SFGH for treatment. The man was retained at SFGH and the warrant was reinstated for later service (041 251 505).

On February 14, at 8:00 a.m., Bayview Officer Miller handled a graffiti call at Burton High School and was informed by a school employee that a student had been "tagging" the word "caller." The student, 15 years of age and living on San Jose Avenue, was cited for vandalism (050 174 627).

On February 14, at 9:46 a.m., Bayview Officer Lavin responded to 23rd and Pennsylvania on the report of homeless people living in a van. The officer found two individuals in the van and determined that one of them was wanted by the United States Marshall's Office. The man, homeless, was arrested and turned over to a Marshall's deputy. During this investigation, information was developed regarding a Bayview burglar who had recently been identified in a video tape taken during the commission of a series of burglaries. Officers Lavin and Petterson spoke with the assigned Burglary Inspector in the case and then responded to a motel in South San Francisco to locate the burglar. The man, homeless, was arrested and booked for the prior burglaries. He was also charged with possession of burglar tools as he had lock picks in his pockets at the time of the arrest (041 347 126).

On February 14, at 11:40 a.m., Bayview Officer Reyes responded to the 300 block of Bacon on the report of a landlord / tenant fight. The callers told the officer that their tenant had threatened and battered them

following an argument about a pending eviction. The tenant was booked for two counts of battery and for making threats (050 175 603).

On February 14, at 1:55 p.m., Bayview Officer Whitney took a report from a man who stated that he had been robbed at 3rd and Paul. The victim stated that he had been at 3rd and Paul when he was approached by a man who told him to "break yourself," which is street slang for, "You are now being robbed." The victim pushed the suspect away and the suspect fled. The suspect is a black male, 21-25, 6'2", 200, wearing a black coat, white T-shirt, and black jeans (050 176 231).

On February 14, at 2:06 p.m., Bayview Officers Kwan and Hui responded to the 1700 block of Revere on a call of shots being fired. The officers interviewed the caller who stated that he had been driving on Lane at Oakdale when a series of shots rang out and he realized one or more shots had struck his car. The caller stated that he saw a man standing at Oakdale and Newhall holding a gun following the shots being fired. The man with the gun jumped into a 1990's Pontiac Grand Am, 4 door black, dark tinted windows, chrome rims, license plate similar to 5BGG642. The suspect is a black male, 15-20, 5'3", 140, black head covering, black pea coat, dark pants (050 176 350).

On February 14, at 2:36 p.m., Bayview Officers Darnell and Berge were on patrol at Revere and Keith when they stopped a vehicle for traffic violations. The driver was found to be an unlicensed driver and was also found to have an outstanding warrant for his arrest. The driver, living in Daly City, was booked for both (050 176 485).

On February 14, at 11:10 p.m., Bayview Officers Festa and Cruz responded to a home on Harbor Road on the report of a person breaking in. The caller told officers that a subject who used to do "odd jobs" around her house was restrained from coming near her home and had been there moments earlier. The subject is homeless and fled after the police were summoned (050 178 033).

On February 14, at 11:50 p.m., Bayview Officers Buelow and Olson responded to 550 18th Street on a call of trespassers. This building has been broken into several times by homeless people who have been cutting the locks and then utilizing the various utilities in the building. The officers found three persons (along with a pit bull dog) inside the premises and placed them under arrest. The first suspect was booked for trespassing, illegal lodging, and an outstanding arrest warrant charging him violation of parole. The second and third suspects were booked for trespassing and illegal lodging (050 178 209).

On February 15, at 1:30 a.m., a woman walked into Bayview Station and reported that she had just been robbed by three men at 3rd and Williams (just down the street from Bayview Station). The victim stated that she had been waiting for the Muni bus when she was approached by three suspects who pulled her hair and punched her in the face. The suspects then stole the victim's property and fled on foot. Suspect one is a black female, 5'5", 120, wearing a white halter top, blue jean skirt and sandals. Suspect two is a black male, 6'0", wearing a green Army jacket. Suspect three is a black male, 5'10", beard with a rubber band?, wearing a black

puffy jacket with ski boots (050 178 340).

On February 15, at 4:17 a.m., Bayview Officer Cahill was on patrol at Davidson and Rankin when he found two persons smoking crack cocaine in a parked Mercedes. The driver, living in Daly city, was found to also be in possession of crack cocaine and was booked for simple possession and also possession of narcotics paraphernalia (050 178 522).
