Crime and Enforcement Update

Knife Assault, 4830 3rd Street, August 14, 1:45 a.m.

When the male told the woman that he was not interested in a romantic relationship, the woman stabbed him. The man was even less interested in a romantic relationship with the woman following the stabbing and drove himself to the hospital. The woman, known as "Tamisia," is 20 years of age, 5'5", 130, straightened hair to ears, wearing a blue jean jacket and blue jean pants (050 908 824).
