Strongarm Robbery

Bayview Officers Anderson and Farrell responded an met a woman who said she was robbed. She told the officers that she saw a man at a bus stop, which is located in front of her house. As she walked by him to go to her front door, the man grabbed her purse and tried to pull it from her shoulder. The woman held on an refused to let go. The man then hit her in the face 8-12 times. The woman still refused to let go and screamed. The man ran away. Numerous officers searched for the suspect with negative results. The woman was transported to St. Luke's Hospital for treatment. The suspect is described as: Black male, 15-18 yrs. old, 5'5", 150 lbs.

Shots Fired Bayview/Cameron 0357 hrs.

Bayview Officers Batchelder and Singh and numerous units responded on a report of shots being fired. There was no suspect description, so the officers began walking in the area to see if they could find out if there was in fact a shooting. They a saw a man walking nearby an attempted to contact him. As the man turned around a corner, he began running away. Believing that the man was somehow involved in the shooting, the officers began chasing him. He was caught a short distance away with the help of other Bayview officers. The man did not have any weapons on him.

The officers continued to search for a shooting suspect or victim when they came across a group of approximately 20 people. The group said that they did not see or hear anything and then began to harass the officers.

When the officers found 19 expended rifle casings nearby, the group quickly dispersed.

No witnesses or victims were found. The man the officers chased was released at the scene.

Attempted Armed Robbery/Gun 1300 block of Carroll 0524 hrs.

Bayview Officers Batchelder, Whitfield, Borgen, Anderson, and Norris responded on a report of a man with a gun. Upon arrival, they met a man who said that he was just shot at. He said that he was unloading his truck when the suspect walked up to him and pointed a handgun at him. The suspect demanded money and the man complied. The man then ran away. About a half block away the man stopped and took out his cell phone. When the suspect saw this he fired 3 shots at the man, but missed him. The area was search with negative results.
