Off Leash Dog Parks

We just received an updated "Dog Violations" charging sheet, and attached to the sheet is a list of all the "Off-Leash" parks in San Francisco. There are two areas in our district (or nearby) where dogs can be run off-leash, and they are McLaren Park (top of the hill at Shelley and Mansell, and the south section via the 1600 block of Geneva), and the Potrero Hill mini-park at 22nd and Arkansas. Crime and Enforcement Update

Cocaine Arrest, Carroll and Phelps, April 4, 4:37 a.m.
Bayview Officer Daniels was on patrol when he saw a man driving and stopped the man, knowing his license was suspended. The man was arrested and his vehicle was impounded, and a booking search revealed four rocks of crack cocaine in his pockets. The man, living on the 1700 block of Yosemite, was booked for possession of cocaine, driving with a suspended license, and other traffic offenses (050 368 234).

Warrant Arrest, Keith and Revere, April 4, 7:06 a.m.
Bayview Officer Altorfer was on patrol when he had occasion to speak with a woman who was wanted for an outstanding arrest warrant. The woman, living on the 5600 block of 3rd Street, was booked for a warrant charging her with possession of cocaine for sale (050 368 347).

Illegal Lodging, 16th and Illinois, April 4, 7:32 a.m.
Bayview Officer Lavin responded on a call of numerous people living in abandoned buildings. These buildings are about to be razed and Officer Lavin brought representatives from the Mayor's Homeless Outreach Team with her to speak with the individuals about services (these same individuals have been offered this information by Officer Lavin on numerous occasions and have declined to avail themselves of the services). Officer Lavin found numerous persons residing in the buildings, along with several stolen shopping carts, and numerous piles of debris, refuse, and human waste. Six individuals were cited for illegal lodging (050 368 397).

Warrant Arrest, 1901 25th Street, April 4, 8:19 a.m.
Bayview Officers Siguido and Pascua responded on a report of a couple fighting and spoke with both individuals who stated they had only been

arguing and no physical violence had taken place. The man, a transient, was found to have an outstanding arrest warrant and was booked for it (050 368 488).

Warrant Arrest, 1700 Newcomb, April 4, 11:20 a.m.
Bayview Officers Stoumen, Izaguirre, Scott and Lyons were on patrol when they saw three individuals engaged in what appeared to be a drug sale. The individuals were detained, and one of them, living on the first block of Reardon Road, was found to have an outstanding warrant for her arrest. The woman was booked for a warrant charging her with trespassing and three counts of petty theft with a prior (050 369 442).

Burglary Suspect Identified, 435 23rd Street, April 4, 2:03 p.m.
Bayview Officers Lamma and Doherty were notified by our Crime Scenes Unit that two fingerprints had been lifted and identified (via our fingerprint computer) for a burglary case the officers had previously handled. The officers responded back to the business to inquire if the person identified via prints had ever worked for the company. The person had not, and the officers showed the individual's mug shot to other officers, and Bayview's homeless coordinator recognized the man as a transient who has been staying near 16th and Illinois. The man wanted for the burglary is Zachary Paul Davis, white male, born 1984, 5'7", 130, brown hair, brown eyes, prior address in Monterey Park, California (050 340 248).

Warrant Arrest, Rankin and Evans, April 4, 3:30 p.m.
Bayview Officer Lavin responded on a call from Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad that numerous people were blocking their tracks and they couldn't get through. The officer found one man sorting his debris on the train tracks and he was cited for blocking the tracks. A second man was arrested for an outstanding arrest warrant charging him with possession of stolen property. Both men are transients (050 370 580).

Shots Fired, 1079 Connecticut, April 4, 10:07 p.m.
Bayview Officers Daniels and Winesberry responded to 25th and Connecticut on a report of 15-20 shots being heard in the area. The officers found numerous shell casings in the area, but no victims or witnesses came forward (050 371 942).

Aggravated Assault, 16300 block of Palou, April 4, 11:30 p.m.

Bayview Officers Erb and Johnson responded on a domestic violence call and spoke with the intoxicated female caller who told them that her boyfriend was angry at her for not giving him any money to buy crack, and as a result, he threatened to kill her and throw her out of the window, although not necessarily in that order. The boyfriend then threw a chair at the caller, missing her. The boyfriend was booked for aggravated assault and terrorist threats and an emergency protective order was obtained for the victim (050 372 097).

Cocaine Offense, 1625 Shafter, April 5, 12:02 a.m.
Bayview Officers Norris and Whitfield responded to 1625 Shafter on the report of two men dealing drugs. Dispatch described both dealers to the officers, and also advised them that the dealers were hiding their drugs in a "flower pot." The officers found numerous men loitering in front of the "Pizza Shack," and then searched a white bathtub being used as a flower pot in front of the store. The officers located a stash of crack cocaine wrapped in a plastic bag inside a Styrofoam cup. The officers seized the drugs and booked them as evidence (050 372 304).

Shooting, Newcomb and Newhall, April 5, 12:15 a.m.
Bayview Officers Bradford and Gallo responded to 3rd and Newcomb on a report of shots being fired. The officers were then notified that a shooting victim had just driven himself to SFGH and they responded to the hospital. The officers found the victim's car outside the doors of the hospital and saw that it had numerous bullet holes in it, as well as blood from the victim. The victim told officers that he had been sitting in his car when an unknown person shot at him twenty times for an unknown reason. The victim later changed his story but provided no additional useful details about suspects or motive. A crime scene was located at Newcomb and Newhall, and numerous casings from at least two different firearms were found at the scene. Two vehicles found at the scene were also found to have numerous fresh bullet holes in them and were towed as evidence (050 372 207).

Marijuana Arrest, 3000 San Bruno, April 5, 12:41 a.m.
Bayview Officers Kenney and Archini were on patrol when they saw a man they knew to be wanted and arrested him. The officers found a stash of marijuana in the man's car, as well as a bullet resistant vest. The man

was transported to Bayview Station and the officers became suspicious when they saw the man continually putting his hands into the back of pants. The officers searched the man and 24 baggies of marijuana, along with 15 pills of suspected ecstasy, fell from the man's buttocks as he was being searched. The man, living on the 1400 block of LaSalle, was booked for numerous drug and traffic charges (050 372 229).
