Program Requirements

- Family members must have lived together for at least one year.
- Must complete 500 hours of "sweat equity" on the construction of their home.
- Must not have owned a home for the past three years.
- All household members (over 18 years old who are not full time students) whose income will contribute to the household gross income must be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident of the U.S. (green card)
- Household income between 40-60% of the median gross annual income for San Francisco households of comparable size based on U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) guidelines:

September 2, 2008-Robbery-4:14pm-Gilman/Jennings-CN#080928955:

Officer Hennessey and Paul responded to the 100 blk of Cameron Way regarding a possible robbery w/force incident. Officers spoke with the victim who stated that while walking home from school, the suspect approached him and asked to use his phone. The victim told the suspect that his phone was not charged. The suspect became angry and pushed the victim into a parked car, pushed the victim's head down and took his cell phone and MP3 Player. The victim left and returned with his father, who was able to get the phone back from the suspect. The victim and his father returned home and called police, who were at the time, responding to another robbery involving the same suspect. The suspect was positively identified. Officers cited the suspect and transported him to a juvenile facility where he was placed into the custody of his probation officer.

September 3, 2008-Robbery-6:01pm-Jennings/Gilman-CN#080929301:

Officer Tam and Training Officer Borgen responded to Jennings and Gilman regarding a robbery. Officers met with the victim who stated that he had been robbed by two suspects. The victim told Officers that he was walking down the street when the two suspects approached him and asked to use his cell phone. The victim told the suspects he did not have a phone. The larger of the two suspects took the victim by the neck, slammed him against the wall, punched him in the face, and took his backpack. The victim fled and called the police. Officers responded to the scene and located one of the suspects. The juvenile suspect was diverted to a juvenile facility and charged with robbery.

September 2, 2008-Aggravated Assault on Police Officer, Warrant Arrest-9:17am-1000 blk of Key st-CN#080927189:

Officer Saw and Catlett were on patrol when they saw a green Cadillac with a broken tail lamp in front of them. Officers recognized the driver from prior arrests. Officers attempted to pull the vehicle over, but the suspect pulled abruptly away from the curb and sped off. A short distance later, the suspect stopped the vehicle abruptly, jumped out of the car and fled from the scene. Officers detained the suspect, who physically fought with officers for several minutes before they were able to place him into custody. The suspect was placed under arrest and booked for assault on a police officer as well as an outstanding warrant that he had. The officers were not seriously injured.

September 4, 2008-Aggravated Assault w/knife-Suspicious Acts Towards Female-1:15am-Evans/Mendell-CN#080934548:

Officer Fong and Borghesani responded to Evans St regarding a person with a knife. Officers met with the victim who told them that an unknown suspect had pulled a knife on her when she got a ride from him. The victim told officers that the suspect had held a box cutter to her face and told her that they were going to "do this his way."
