ARRESTS OF INTEREST:

Thursday, November 20, 2008 – 9:30 AM – Robbery with a gun – Dakota Street – CS# 081 242 536 – At 1:30 in the afternoon a man flagged down Officer McGuire and Ng and told him that he was robbed in the Potrero Hill Housing complex hours earlier. The man told the officers that he was visiting a female friend and was walking to his car when he saw four males approach him. The man grew suspicious and picked up the pace. The group of males caught up to him as the victim was getting into his car and one of them brandished a handgun. Another male said, "Give me everything." The man gave the suspects his wallet.

The man was able to give the officers a good description of some the suspects that robbed him. Officer McGuire and Ng drove through the area and saw the suspected group. The group began to slowly walk away and attempted to hide their faces. Officer McGuire and Ng parked their car around the block and out of sight. They crept around the buildings until they saw the group again. This time the group turned around and walked away from the officers. The officers ordered the group to stop. Two of them did and two of them ran off. The two that stayed were detained. The victim was brought to the scene where he identified one of the persons that robbed him. The suspect, a young adult from Sacramento was booked.

Thursday, November 20, 2008 - 11:00 AM – Criminal Threats – 1500 block of Shafter – CS# 081 242 699 – Officers Hastings and Seto responded to a residence on the 1500 block of Shafter Avenue regarding a woman that was being threatened by her sister in law. The final straw was when the sister in law stole the victim's elderly uncle's wallet with over \$100.00 the night prior.
