### **SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS:**

#### **JULY 19, 2008-Homicide, w/gun-7:21hrs-Industrial/Bayshore-CN#080759813:**

Numerous Bayview Station officers responded to Industrial & Bayshore regarding a shooting. Officers spoke with witnesses who heard the shots and saw the victim get off of a motorcycle, run to the sidewalk on Bayshore and collapse to the ground. The witnesses approached the victim to render aid and realized the victim had been shot in the chest. The victim was able to speak with the paramedics, but would not speak with officers regarding who shot him. The victim was taken to S.F.G.H. where he later succumbed to his injuries. Officers searched the area for a possible suspect and vehicle, to no avail.

The Homicide Division is investigating this incident. Any information should be directed to the Homicide Division at 415-553-1145 or to the SFPD Anonymous Tip Line, 575-4444 which is staffed by a live person 24-hrs a day.

### **ARRESTS OF INTEREST:**

Numerous Bayview Officers responded to the area of Westbrook and Hudson Ct regarding a suspect with a gun. Officer McGuire and Officer Rosenberg spoke with a victim who said that he was working on his car on the street, when two unknown suspects walked up to him. One of the suspects pointed a silver gun at the victim. The victim immediately ducked down while running away. The victim, who was not injured during the incident, returned to his car several minutes later and met with the police. Officers chased an additional armed suspect who dropped a gun, then picked it up and continued running from the police. While nobody was injured during the incident, the bullet had traveled and lodged into the sheetrock wall, which adjoined the room where the victim had been sleeping when the shooting occurred.
