REGULAR MEETING

The Police Commission of the City and County of San Francisco met in Room 400, City Hall, #1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, at 5:58 p.m., in a Regular Meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Inspector Frank Lee, Sex Crimes Detail, presented the Commission with a petition in regards to interview process of the Homicide Detail.

David Villalobos, Director of Community Leadership Alliance, talked about the meet-and-greet forum and discussed concerns regarding two liquor stores at Turk and Taylor Streets.

Barry Tarranto, cab driver, discussed concerns regarding officer working 10b at the Hilton Hotel and concerns regarding illegal limousines.

Commissioner Veronese asked why the Department is giving the report as opposed to the OCC Director. Ms. Hicks stated that it would be more appropriate to have the Department report to the Commission about delays and for OCC to respond. Commissioner Sparks asked that a copy of the report be provided to Director Hicks before the presentation.

Inspector Joseph McFadden presented the OIS Investigation Status Summary.

Commissioner Sparks commended Inspector McFadden and Deputy Chief Keohane for a job well done.

Deputy Chief Keohane presented the 4th Quarter 2007 Firearm Discharge Review Board Report.

Chief Fong introduced Ms. Ronnie Wagner, Attorney, Management Control Division. Ms. Wagner gave a brief background about herself.

Lieutenant John Murphy presented the 2007 homicide overview report. Commissioner Sparks asked that this item be put over for next week to give the Commission a chance to look over the documents.
