The San Francisco Police Department investigated a homicide that occurred on June 13th, 2014, at approximately 9:15 AM in San Francisco's Mission District. Homicide victim, Dominic Anderson, 25 years old, was shot in the area of 15th and Mission Streets where he was found by officers. Medics were immediately called to the scene and transported Mr. Anderson to San Francisco General Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. Investigators from our Homicide Unit in the Major Crimes Division worked tirelessly to identify San Francisco resident, Justin Howard, 25 years old, as the person responsible for Mr. Anderson's death. On July 9, Howard was located and arrested at his girlfriend's house in Richmond, CA by the San Francisco Police Department.
