The San Francisco Police Department and The California Highway Patrol issued a total of 126 citations during yesterday's joint traffic enforcement operation.

San Francisco Police issued a total of 89 citations and California Highway Patrol issued 37 citations. These violations range from using wireless devices (distracted driving), texting while driving, failure to obey posted signs, pedestrian right of ways, stop sign, red light, seat belt and suspended license.
