San Francisco Police Are Seeking Public Assistance in Locating Muni Stabbing Suspect 21-130

On Thursday, June 10, 2021, at approximately 4:30 p.m., San Francisco Police officers from Northern Station responded to the area of Steiner and Green Streets regarding a stabbing that took place on a Muni bus. Officers located the 31-year-old male victim on the bus suffering from stab wounds. Officers rendered aid to the victim and summoned medics to the scene. The victim told officers that he was seated on the bus when the suspect, who was sitting adjacent to him, stood up and stabbed him two times. The suspect then exited the bus and fled on foot. The victim did not know the suspect, had no prior interaction and said the attack was unprovoked.

The victim was transported to a local hospital where he was treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

The incident is being investigated by the Northern Station Investigations Team and SFPD's Muni Task Force.

The suspect is described as a black male adult, in his 20's or 30's. He is approximately 6'0" 160 lbs. with brown hair and brown eyes. He was last seen wearing a black Northface jacket, dark blue jeans, and adidas shoes with gold or white stripes. Photos of the suspect accompany this news release.
