On February 10, 2022, at approximately 12:52 a.m., San Francisco Police officers responded to the 4600 block of Irving Street regarding a report of a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located a victim suffering from a gunshot wound. Officers rendered aid and summoned medics to the scene who transported the victim to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The shooting suspect fled the scene in a vehicle after an exchange of gunfire with the victim. Approximately 20 minutes later, officers received a report of a shooting victim in a stationary vehicle on Great Highway near Skyline Boulevard. Officers arrived on scene at Great Highway and located the vehicle and the male suspect suffering from a gunshot wound. Officers rendered aid and summoned medics to the scene, but despite lifesaving efforts, the male succumbed to his injuries and was declared deceased on scene. The preliminary investigation determined that the suspect drove from Irving Street after suffering a gunshot wound and succumbed to his injuries on Great Highway.
