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Uniform and Professional Attire
(Re-issue DB 16-011)

All full duty sworn members of the Department shall wear the uniform of the day while on duty. Sworn members who are not full duty due to any medical or administrative reason shall wear court attire (as described in Department General Order 3.08) while on duty.

Sworn members shall not “cover” their uniforms or patches while on duty in public (traveling to meetings, eating meals, etc.).

Non-sworn members whose classifications and functions require a uniform shall ensure that they are in their designated uniform of the day while on duty. Non-sworn members who are not required to wear a uniform while on duty shall maintain professional/business attire.

Commanding Officers shall regularly inspect their members and maintain compliance with these policies.
