## **Position Opening: Mountain Bike Unit (MBU)**

The Field Operations Bureau is currently accepting applications from Officers, Sergeants, and Lieutenants for part-time positions in the Mountain Bike Unit (MBU). Members chosen for this assignment will remain in their current assignments and be detailed as needed to the MBU.

\*Members who previously participated in the MBU during APEC must apply if interested in continuing to be part of the Unit.

### **Duties include but are not limited to:**

- Facilitation 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment activities (i.e., protests and demonstrations)
- Special events (i.e., parades, festivals, etc.)
- Mobile bicycle patrol
- Enforcement operations
- Community outreach events

### **Assignment schedule:**

- This will be a part-time assignment.
- Members must be willing to work on an overtime basis, have their schedule adjusted, and extended hours if necessary.
- Members must be willing to attend additional training as scheduled.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

\* Minimum qualifications must be met by the application deadline, unless otherwise stated.

- Hold the rank of Officer, Sergeant, or Lieutenant
- Must have completed probation as an Officer or Sergeant or Lieutenant with SFPD.
- Must have successfully completed a POST bicycle training course or successfully complete the course within 6 months of selection to MBU.

### **Additional desirable qualifications include but are not limited to:**

- Previous bicycle patrol experience.
- Ability to work in a team environment.
- Physical fitness abilities to ride a bicycle for long distances and/or for extended periods of time.

**Selection Procedures:**

**Step 1: Deadline**

- The application deadline will be Saturday, June 8th 2024.

**Step 2: How to apply**

Once your application is received, you will receive a confirmation email within 5 business days.

**Step 3: Selection Process**

- The selection process will consist of:
  1. A review of submitted applications and resumes (if included) to ensure all applicants meet the minimum requirements.
  2. In lieu of oral interviews, candidate's written responses to the application questions will be reviewed by a panel to determine selection.
