NOBLE's 48th Annual Training Conference (Supersedes DN 23-064)

The National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE) was founded in 1976 to exchange views about the high rate of crime in urban communities and the socioeconomic conditions that lead to crime and violence. The mission of NOBLE is “to ensure equity in the administration of justice in the provision of public service to all communities, and to serve as the conscience of law enforcement by being committed to justice by action.”

NOBLE's 48th Annual Training Conference will be held in New Orleans, LA on August 10-13, 2024. The upcoming Training Conference is an international gathering that will bring together over 2000 law enforcement professionals who represent cities and communities across the nation and the world. The symposium will showcase leading law enforcement leaders at the federal, state, and local levels. The conference includes workshops focused on:
